Letter to Families regarding Covid-19

Dear NRCC applicants and families,

We will not require campers at NRCC to be vaccinated. However, we do strongly request that all campers get vaccinated before camp starts.

A camper who has been vaccinated does not need to be tested. If you get the vaccine, please let me know. I will also need a copy of your vaccination card.

If you do not get vaccinated, you must get the NAAT test within 72 hours of arriving at NRCC and bring proof of a negative test. You will also need to bring enough cloth masks to wear for the week. If you test positive, please contact me immediately to let me know that you will not be attending NRCC.

Vaccinated campers should bring one mask. Masks should completely cover mouth and nose.

All campers and staff will have their temperature taken each morning and will fill out a health survey on symptoms each morning.

How relaxed mask-wearing and physical distancing will be at NRCC will depend upon how many campers and staff have been vaccinated.

Our hope is that we can relax restrictions and requirements if most (or all) of those spending the week at Hickory have been vaccinated. If you are hesitant or have questions about the vaccine, please talk to your doctor to get your questions answered.

I look forward to seeing you in Garrett County this July. Therefore, in the weeks leading up to NRCC, please take every precaution to avoid situations that could put you at risk for Covid-19. We don't want anyone to miss this amazing week full of great experiences to show you all the natural resource career possibilities in your future.
